

**ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 2.07
 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WALES,
 WAUKESHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN
 PROHIBITING THE VILLAGE FROM MANDATING
 EMPLOYEE BENEFITS FOR PRIVATE BUSINESSES**

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF WALES, WAUKESHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN,
 DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 2.07 of the Village Code of the Village of Wales is hereby created to
 read as follows:

2.07 : MANDATING OF EMPLOYEE BENEFITS FOR PRIVATE BUSINESSES. No ordinance of the Village of Wales nor any other municipal ordinance, rule, or regulation shall mandate that any person, partnership, limited liability corporation or other corporation or business entity or any kind, other than the Village itself, shall provide certain wages or benefits to its employees or set the amount or type of any employee wages or benefits to be provided by an employer located within the Village limits.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with or contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.
