

PARK COMMISSION MEETING MAY 9, 2016

The Park Commission meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Paul Johnson. Members present Paul Johnson, Lyle Orwig, Bill Borghoff and Neal Weibelhaus.

SANTANA DOTSON KICKBALL TOURNAMENT WALES COMMUNITY PARK SHEL DELISLE

DISCUSSION: The Santana Dotson Foundation would like to host their 3rd Annual Kickball Tournament at Wales Community Park on Sunday, June 5, 2016 from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. They will have food and drinks for sale. There will be a raffle. Funds raised will go to support the Santana Dotson Community Outreach for Kids and the Back Pack Coalition. They are thinking of having a bags tournament sponsored by on the local bars, but are not sure if that is going to happen this year. They would need to use 3 fields, and the concession building. The same prep will be provided – clean the building, line the fields, and be there in case of issues. The paperwork for the liquor license and certificate of insurance must be provided to the Village before the event. If they chose to have the event next year, they will not have to come for approval of it, but all paperwork must be submitted and approved.

MOTION: Motion by Neal Weibelhaus to approve the Kickball tournament on June 5, 2016 and waive the fee as submitted, second Bill Borghoff. Motion passed unopposed.

UPDATE FROM VOLUNTEER SOCCER COORDINATOR

DISCUSSION: Scheduling has improved this season. The possible referee reimbursement could have 2-4 kids this year. The soccer committee has one new volunteer and they are looking for more people to help with the program. If there are not some more volunteers to help, the program could be at the end, two people cannot run this program. The decision will be made by December 31st. The committee is looking at getting more coach training. There are 80 registrations so far for the 2016/2017 season. Registrations will be accepted through June 17th.

JOBS FOR CHRISTOPHER

DISCUSSION: The soccer fields are in good shape. The new paint is lasting longer for the lines. The mowers have not had any issues and within the next month all of the summer help will be on staff. They have built a sample trash can out of wood for the disc golf course and will be working on a metal can over the summer. The cost of the proposed metal could cost about \$100 - \$150, where the wood one cost them about

\$250 and to purchase a middle of the road trash can cost about \$400. The white shed at Fireman's has been removed and the ground restored. The old restroom building at Fireman's is going to need to have the roof replaced this summer. The restroom could be used as a storage building if the interior walls could be removed. Christopher should get quotes for the roof. A new disc golf basket needs to be purchased for Wales Community Park. The backstop and fence needs to be removed from Breconshire and then get new grass planted. Maybe a letter should be placed in the next Village newsletter to ask residents what they would like to see happen at Breconshire. A quote was received from Mudjackers to fix the problems with the sidewalks around the buildings in the park - \$6000, a couple more quotes should be submitted. There are other issues with both buildings that are going to need to be addressed: plumbing, electrical and foundation problems.
