

PARK COMMISSION MEETING AUGUST 8, 2016

The Park Commission meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m. by Chairman Paul Johnson. Members present Paul Johnson, Lyle Orwig, Bill Borghoff and Neal Wiebelhaus.

Also Present: Pauline Wigderson, Christopher Johnson, Mary Ziebell, 539 Wakefield Downs; and Sarah Smart from the Wales Business Group.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Sarah Smart from the Wales Business group said that they would like to work/help the Park Commission to have some type of events in Wales. She will attend the next business group meeting to see what they would be able to do or ideas they may have.

Park Commission members acknowledged receipt of the minutes for the Park Commission meeting of July 11, 2016. Motion by Bill Borghoff to approve the minutes and waive the requirement of reading same, second by Neal Wiebelhaus, motion passed, unopposed.

UPDATE FROM VOLUNTEER SOCCER COORDINATOR

DISCUSSION: Neal will be attending the league meeting. The fees will remain the same, \$75, as in previous years. A new club has joined and with that the U12 and U14 teams could travel for a game, but the younger teams will not. There are 23 teams this year, which is less than last year, but the teams have larger numbers to accommodate the loss of players for games. Carol and Neal are trying to get more volunteers for the Soccer Committee, if more volunteers are not found, this could be the last year for Wales Soccer. The coaches meeting will be on August 18th at the Community Building. Practices could start on the 22nd or 29th of August. Games start on September 10th and the last game is on October 29th unless there are make-up games.

DISCUSSION POSSIBLE USE AT BRECONSHIRE

DISCUSSION: The Park Commission would like to move forward with the idea of the fit trail at Breconshire Park. Members of the Park Commission will meet Breconshire Park on August 9, 2016 to see if their idea could happen. If they would like to move forward, The Park Commission will hold a meeting on August 29, 2016 to have a discussion as how to proceed. There could be fund raising, getting a plan together, and getting some other volunteers to help with the fit trail project.

JOBS FOR CHRISTOPHER

DISCUSSION: Christopher and the summer help will be repairing items that were found on the parks walk-through on August 1, 2016. Working on replacing the lights at the parks with LED fixtures. A plumber must be called to fix the running water at Community Park in the restrooms. The broken mirror in the men's room must be replaced. There is a beehive in the toys at Breconshire which must be removed and tighten down the plastic so they don't come back. There is a missing swing and the teatherball string needs to be replaced at Fireman's Park.
